2011 TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Registration forms, registration fees and Calcutta's need to be in the Tournament Directors (Jeremy Kern) hands by Wed. May 18th 2011.
2. We will be doing a shot gun start this year. At 7am on 5/21/11 you must meet me at the launch to receive your "Tourney Card". You can begin fishing once you receive your card. The tournament will end at 5:00pm. At 8am on 5/22/11 we will do the same launch style and you must once again meet me at launch to receive your "new" second day tourney card. If you miss the launch time, you must call me and find me on the water to receive your tourney card.
3. This is a catch and release tournament, any fish that are kept or placed in a livewell will be disqualified from the tournament!
4. The fish must be photographed with tourney card in clear view, prior to releasing the fish.
5. Fish **must** be reported to the Tournament Director (484.809.3769) after the fish is released. (Angler, Fish Length, Time)
6. Fish reported after 3:00pm will not be counted!
7. We will be following Muskies Inc. International Rules so the minimum length for a muskie to count is 30 inches.
8. The tournament category will be Team/Boat Total Inches of legal fish caught. (Prizes for 1st-3rd).
9. Anglers may fish alone if desired.
10. Marsh Creek is an electric trolling motor lake only, **NO GAS MOTORS ALLOWED**. Shore fishing is permitted but again we can pair you up with someone that has an open spot on their boat.
11. Artificial lures only during the tournament, No Live Bait may be used or possessed!
12. PA state law allows a maximum of two rods per angler.
13. Be respectful of other fisherman! Be safe and have fun!

OPTIONAL CALCUTTA RULES

1. The Calcutta is an **optional** category and is not included with the tournament registration fee. The Calcutta is an additional \$10 to enter on top of the registration fee.
2. The Calcutta is awarded to the angler catching the biggest fish, not the team.
3. All regular tourney rules and regulations apply to the Calcutta.
4. This is an optional category and there will be a 100% payout for Big fish of the first day and Big Fish of the second day. The pot will be evenly split between the two days. (Not an actual Calcutta reel)
5. In the event of a tie for the Calcutta, the money will be split evenly.
